## PMCA Holiday Highway Safety Program

Since 1990, PMCA members have donated many thousands of gallons of gasoline to the PMCA Holiday Highways Safety Program. Their generosity has allowed Kansas Highway Patrol troopers to quite literally go the extra mile(s) in helping thousands of motorists arrive safely to their holiday destination.

*To the many PMCA members who participate in this annual program, our sincere thanks for making the holidays happier and safer for motorists traveling through Kansas.*

Through the generous support of PMCA members, last year we were able to provide the Kansas Highway Patrol with more 50 tanks of gasoline or an estimated additional 19,000 miles of driving with no cost for fuel.

We look forward to another successful year.



Each year, during the holiday travel influx that occurs between Christmas and New Year's Day, many PMCA members participate in a one-of-a-kind program that contributes to highway safety during this period of heavy traffic. By donating a tank full of gasoline to their local Kansas Highway Patrol trooper, PMCA members allow the trooper to add some additional patrol time and miles when it is most needed ... and no cost for fuel to the taxpayers of Kansas!

### Here's how the program works:

1. Fill out as many of the gasoline coupons you wish to donate to local trooper(s). The coupons are enclosed with this brochure. Be sure to include the exact location of your participating station(s) so that your local trooper will know where to redeem the coupon.
2. Sign each coupon.
3. Return the completed coupon(s) to PMCA of Kansas no later than December 17, 2019. PMCA will deliver the coupons to the Kansas Highway Patrol headquarters in Topeka for distribution to local troopers in time for the December 22 start-up date.
4. The patrol headquarters will forward the completed coupons to the trooper(s) in your vicinity.
5. Local troopers may redeem the coupons only between December 23, 2019 and January 1, 2020 -- the period of heaviest holiday traffic.
6. When the trooper arrives with the coupon that you have previously signed, please have the trooper sign his/her name, car number and the date.
7. Keep the coupon for your company records.
8. If you would like to contact your local newspaper describing your participation in the 2019 PMCA Holiday Highways Safety Program, we will forward you a "generic" press release. You simply write in your company name and location, then send to your local newspaper. The press release is a good way to inform your community about your efforts to help make Kansas highways safer places during the holidays.
