President's Choice Charity **Allison Chaput Memorial Scholarship**

Allison Chaput was young, vibrant, dedicated nurse who was living a wonderful life in Denver, CO, ran half marathons, competed in 100 mile bike races and regularly hiked in the mountains.

On April 27, 2016 Allison's life changed when she was diagnosed with Stage IV Small Cell Adenocarcinoma. A week after her diagnosis she began chemotherapy treatment which lasted through June 2016. The results of the treatment were mixed. Doctors prescribed the drug Tarceva but unfortunately the insurance company's approval put on hold the Tarceva treatment for about three weeks.

Allison was engaged to be married to the love of her life Ian on October 1, 2016. On August 1st, the day before her bridal shower, Allison was admitted to the hospital to ICU and spent a week and a half there. From ICU she was moved to the oncology floor where her medical team did all they could to help her body heal. While there she took the daily dose of Tarceva seven times. Unfortunately it was no the answer we hoped it would be. Tarceva attacked her liver and kidneys. Allison's family watched as she deteriorated daily. On September 3rd, just a month shy of her wedding day, the angels came and Allison earned her set of wings at the young age of 32.

Allison's family keeps Allison's her spirit alive through a scholarship fund at her alma meter, Fort Hays State University. Annually, a nursing student will receive a scholarship from the Allison Chaput Memorial Scholarship through the Fort Hays State Endowment

Foundation. Allison found her home away from home at her college sorority, Delta Zeta. Her family has also established a recruitment scholarship wit the sorority in her name, both at the Hays, KS chapter and the chapter in Denver, CO.

Despite the cards Allison's family has been dealt, as a family, they seek to find the thanksgiving in this unimaginable outcome. They are blessed that Allison was able to live life to the fullest until she received her angel wings. They are grateful that she was able to experience the beauty and sweetness of love and was able to find joy in planning almost every detail of her wedding. They are grateful for the impromptu trip to the bridal shop to try on her wedding dress for the first and last time.. Lastly, we are grateful for the Lung Force organization. Without your efforts, there would be limited advances in finding a cure. Our prayer is that another family won't have to experience such a devastating circumstance. Ultimately, we are thankful that our Alli will forever be a beautiful, angelic bride.
