**2020 Scholarship Application for

PMCA Pinnacle Scholarship Application for Technical/Vocational or Trade School

The Pinnacle Scholarship Fund was established by the Petroleum Marketers and Convenience Store Association of Kansas for the purpose of awarding scholarships to deserving students from within the industry.

Eligibility

Each scholarship recipient must be one of the following:

- son/daughter or grandchild of a PMCA member;
- child of a full-time employee of a PMCA member; or
- employee of a PMCA member.



Applicant must be at least 17 years-old.

Applicant must be a current high school senior, have graduated from an accredited high school or have attained the equivalency of a high school diploma.

Applicant must plan to attend a Kansas technical/vocational or trade school or currently enrolled in a Kansas technical/vocational or trade school as a full-time (12 hours minimum) student for the fall semester of 2020.

Awards

One technical/vocational or trade school \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded for 2020. The recipient will receive \$500 per semester (second semester award is contingent upon achieving a first semester grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale as reported by the college's financial aid office). Awards are not automatically renewable. Recipient may reapply for the Pinnacle Scholarship for the second year contingent upon fulfillment of selection criteria, including a GPA of no lower than 2.5 cumulative on a 4.0 scale.

Application

Each applicant must complete the Pinnacle Scholarship Application and return it along with a current **official** transcript of grades, 500-word typewritten letter outlining educational and/or career objectives, letter of recommendation from school administrator or employer and letter of recommendation from PMCA member.

Selection of Recipients

Scholarship recipients will be selected by a selection committee consisting of one PMCA member who is not a director and who is not related to any applicant, one college or university professor and one business man or woman not affiliated with the petroleum marketing industry in Kansas.

Selection committee will conduct a careful review of each applicant's academic standing, school and community service, 500-word essay of educational goal and/or objectives and personal references.

Payment of Scholarships

Checks will be mailed to recipient's home address and will be made payable jointly intly to the recipient and the school and must be endorsed by both.

Applications for 2020 Pinnacle Scholarships must be postmarked no later than February 28, 2020. Recipients will be notified by April 1, 2020. Check for the fall semester 2020 will be mailed to recipients prior to beginning of the fall semester.
